THIS POLICY

After your initial visit to In line Conning Holdings Limited's ("**Conning**"/ "**we**"/ "**us**"/ "**our**" as applicable) website (the "**Website**"), we may change the cookies we use. Our [Cookie List](#) below will always allow you to know who is placing cookies, for what purpose and give you the means to disable them so you should check it from time to time.

Where the organization setting the cookie provides an automated disabling tool in respect of its cookie(s) we list the name of that organization, the category of cookies it sets together with a link to its automated disabling tool. In all other cases, we list the names of the cookies themselves and their source at the date of this Cookies policy so that you can easily identify and disable them if you want through your browser controls.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating web domain on your subsequent visits to that domain. Most web pages contain elements from multiple web domains so when you visit the Website, your browser may receive cookies from several sources.

Cookies are useful because they allow a website to recognize a user's device. Cookies allow you to navigate between pages efficiently, remember preferences and generally improve the user experience. They can also be used to tailor advertising to your interests through tracking your browsing across websites.

Session cookies are deleted automatically when you close your browser and persistent cookies remain on your device after the browser is closed (for example to remember your user preferences when you return to the site).

HOW DOES CONNING USE COOKIES?

Conning uses different types of cookies to provide our services to you. Generally, these can be separated into the following categories:

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the website and use its features. Without these cookies, services you have asked for (such as navigating between pages) cannot be provided.

Analytics Cookies

We make use of analytic cookies to analyze how our visitors use our Website and to monitor Website performance. This allows us to provide a high-quality experience by customizing our offering and quickly identifying and fixing any issues that arise. For example, we might use performance cookies to keep track of which pages are most popular, which method of linking between pages is most effective, and to determine why some pages are receiving error messages. We might also use these cookies to highlight articles or site services that we think will be of interest to you based on your usage of the website. The information collected by these cookies is not associated with your personal information by us or by our contractors.

The Website currently uses the following analytic cookies from Google Analytics. These cookies are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help

us improve our site. The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited.

Functionality Cookies

We may make use of cookies to provide you with certain functionality. For example, cookies may be used to remember choices you make (such as your user name, language or the region you are in), to recognize the platform from which you access the site, or to provide enhanced and more personal features. Cookies may also be used to identify and address functionality issues with the site.

Advertising Cookies

Advertising cookies (or targeting cookies) collect information about the browsing habits associated with your device and are used to make advertising more relevant to you and your interests. They are also used by services provided by third parties on this Website, such as 'Like' or 'Share' buttons in addition to providing the requested functionality. Third parties provide these services in return for recognizing that you (or more accurately your device has) have visited a certain website. These third parties put down advertising cookies both when you visit our Website and when you use their services and navigate away from our Website.

PERSONAL DATA TRANSFERS (EEA/UK RESIDENTS)

This part of our policy is for residents in the EEA/UK. When using cookies, we may send your personal data to other countries, like the United States, where they might not have the same privacy protections as in the EEA/UK.

Before we share your personal data with people in other countries, we do things to ensure they keep your data safe such as getting contractual guarantees by using the EU Standard Contractual Clauses and the UK International Data Transfer Addendum. In other instances, where the European Commission believes a country has sufficient privacy laws, we use an 'adequacy decision' as the basis of a transfer.
